The Small Print

Equipment required

The boats entered should be '**seaworthy**', and include **securely fitted buoyancy** to prevent loss during a capsize. And should not hinder egress should you capsize. Please no K1 racers or waveskis. Rutland Water can get a bit rough. Please, no solo canoes, in F4 conditions you may not be able to steer a good course.

Boats should be clean and dry when they arrive for the event to avoid the introduction of destructive invasive species (see club blog entry)

Each paddler will need; **buoyancy aid, whistle, an extra layer to wear in the event of a capsize.**

The team will need; **first aid kit, mobile phone (for emergency or when abandoning race), watch (time penalties for being late)**

Event Data Protection Policy

Rutland Canoe Club takes your privacy seriously (no really!). We will use your personal data solely to administer your event entry. Some of this data (your name and club) may also appear on our club website or blog or internal newsletter. The details of this are outlined below.

How your information will be used

We will use your personal data for administering your event entry. We will not use your information to contact you before or after the event unless responding to a specific request. Event relevant information will be published on our blog.

By entering the RCC Treasure Hunt 2018 you agree that we may also publish your name and club as part of the results and rankings of the event, and may pass such information to British Canoeing. This is primarily for the purpose of insurance for you attending the event as a club taster session.

How will my information be stored and how long will it be retained

Your registration form will be scanned after the event and kept on offline storage. We will keep the files for three calendar years after the event in order to allow for any possible insurance claims. After then, the information will be deleted.
